

How will you help me settle in?




We know that it is a big change moving to a new school, so we do lots of things to help you settle in and feel at home.

In the spring, a teacher from Falcon Junior will visit you at your Infant Schools to tell you all about us.

You will also come and visit us for a games afternoon and lunch. This will give you a chance to see your new school and teacher and meet some new friends.

Before you start here, your school will tell us all about you. You will also write about yourself to help your teacher get to know you. You can tell them what you love doing, what you enjoy at school and what you need help with.



Some of you may worry about finding your way round the school, so you will play some games when you start which will help you find out where everything is.

We are all very kind and friendly here and you can ask anyone for help, but you will also have a 'buddy' from Year 4 who will be there to help you settle in.

Our Year 4 children have asked us to mention a couple of things which you may find different from Infant School. When you come into school in the morning, you will say "goodbye" to your grown-ups in the playground. You will then line up and your teacher will take you into school.

At lunchtime, if you have a hot school meal, you will collect your own lunch from the serving hatch, and when you have finished your main course, you do not have to ask permission to eat your dessert. You can just tuck in.



What new work will I do?



You will study lots of new and fascinating things at Falcon Junior School.

You will study English, Maths, Computing, Science, Geography, History, R.E., Design and Technology, Art and Design, Music, P.E., Games, RSHE and French. You will also go swimming, using the pool in a nearby school.

You will focus on a different topic in detail each half term. So, for example, in the 'Stone Age' topic you will enjoy studying how our ancient ancestors lived.

We have an 'Accelerated Reader' programme to encourage your love of reading. We have visits from authors, book fairs where you can look at new books, and fancy-dress World Book Days.

What else is different?

As you will be going into Year 3, you will be encouraged to become more independent and responsible.

So, for example, you will start to organise some parts of your learning yourself. You will also need to remember to take home your own reading book, spellings and times tables sheet.

You can bring your own pencil case as we know that lots of you will love using your own special pens and pencils.





What new things are you looking forward to doing at Falcon Junior?


What clubs and other activities can I take part in?

You can have music lessons for guitar, drums, flute and recorder and join the Rock Steady Band.




We also have Art and Science clubs.

You can earn points for your team through doing well in your lessons, taking part in team activities or through other achievements.





How will Falcon Junior School look after me and my family?
