Additional responsibilities of a link governor for a year group

- To develop and maintain an ongoing supportive link between the governing board and staff working in the linked year group.
- To meet termly (where possible) with the head of year, and where available other year staff, to develop an understanding of the priorities and challenges for the year, how plans are progressing, and to offer governor support.
- To develop an understanding of the school's intent in relation to the curriculum for the year, how this is implemented, and how impact is measured. (For example, being familiar with curriculum maps, agreed action plans, and how pupils are assessed).
- To liaise with other year link governors to understand how the curriculum builds as pupils progress from years 3 to 6.
- To report work done in the role to the Full Governing Board, and to follow up identified actions.
- To support and participate in the agreed programme of governor monitoring (including an expectation to attend at least one 'deep dive' per year).
