We will soon be beginning our Relationships and Sex Education (RSE) at Falcon Junior School. We use "RSE Solution", a scheme of work from Educator Solutions in Norfolk. This ensures that we will be delivering exactly what the Department for Education expects schools to be teaching. We amend lesson plans where appropriate using teachers' professional judgement.

In Year 6, we will be teaching the following topics:

Pupils can recognise how images in the media, including online do not always reflect reality, and can affect how people feel about themselves.	Pupils can explain what sexual intercourse is and how this leads to reproduction, using the correct terms to describe the male and female organs.	Pupils realise the nature and consequences of discrimination, including the use of prejudice based language.	Pupils have an awareness that infections can be shared during sexual intercourse, and that a condom can help prevent this.	Pupils develop the confidence and skills to know when, who and how to ask for help independently, or with support.

Parents have the right to withdraw their children from the non-statutory sex education lessons in Year 6; it is the parents' responsibility to contact the school regarding this.
